Tonight's meeting minute notes: All votes by the Village of Earlville Board of Trustees (herein "Board" or "Village Board") 5-0 are to be read as "aye" votes from Village of Earlville Board of Trustees members Corey, Hayes, Moore and Piliero. The "Village Office" is the Village of Earlville Municipal Office located at 8 North Main Street. The "Planning Board" means the Village of Earlville Planning Board.

Mayor William Excell called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Board members present were Trustees Margaret Corey, Gerald Hayes, Henry Moore and Daniel Piliero. Also present was Village Clerk-Treasurer Kelly Beach, and 2 members of the public.

TRUSTEE REPORTS

NEW BUSINESS

A resident would like to host a Zombie Walk in Earlville at Halloween time. She has been in contact with Dode and they have discussed the merits of having this event. The event would include people paying a fee to dress up as a zombie and walk in a parade from Quick Way to the old school; with a bonfire following the parade at the old school. Mayor Excell stated that she should work with the Events Committee and get all the info together and then present it to the Board for approval. He also advised her to talk to John Fontaine, the Fire Chief about the Fire Department members attending the bonfire on standby. She asked what was needed to be done to block off the street from Quick Way to the school and would it be okay with the board? Trustee Hayes suggested she attend the Fire Dept. meeting tomorrow night and explain her idea to them. Trustee Moore stated that she should also go to the Events Committee meeting next Tuesday at 2:30pm. Trustee Hayes asked if this would be a fund raiser event; yes the funds raised would go to the Earlville Free Library, and the Library would donate a portion to the Earlville Events Committee.

A Public Hearing will be held at 6:30p.m. on Tuesday, September 16, 2014 to discuss the proposed Local Law #1 of 2014, which is titled "A Local Law Providing For The Administration and Enforcement of the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code".

OLD BUSINESS

Trustee Hayes has finished the hazard mitigation report and will be returning the form in the next few days.

A letter from Janet Holt regarding a violation given by the previous Codes Officer was read by Trustee Hayes. She was given a violation letter for not having house numbers visible from the road. Trustee Hayes stated that many residents received the same letter from Van Huesen. Mayor Excell will visit her and thank her for taking care of the situation. Trustees feel that the violation letters should not have been given, that the issue should have been handled in a better manner. Hayes will speak to the Fire Dept. tomorrow regarding whether they would like to sell house numbers to residents.


