Village Mayor Toni Campbell called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m. Board members present were Trustees Mark Doeberl, Gerald Hayes and Henry Moore. Trustee William Excell was absent. Also present was Village Clerk-Treasurer Christian Vischi.

The Hamilton Township/Atlantic County, N.J. had a listing on www.govdeals.com, including five ramps and assorted accessories for a Skate Park. The equipment was listed as less than four years old. After discussion on the village's equipment, a recent Youth Committee meeting and a Clean-Up Day, Trustee Doeberl made a motion that the board allows Clerk-Treasurer Vischi to bid on the skate park equipment up to a maximum of \$2,500. It was seconded by Trustee Moore. During discussion, Trustees Moore and Hayes said they felt comfortable with no more than \$2,000. Trustee Doeberl then amended the motion that \$2,100 would come from the village's General Fund and a maximum of \$410 would come from the Youth Savings Fund. It was seconded by Trustee Moore and carried 3-0.

Trustee Hayes made a motion, seconded by Trustee Doeberl and carried 3-0, to allow the Clerk and Mayor to attend NYCOM's 100th Annual Meeting June 28-July 1, attending Monday and Tuesday, and staying overnight Monday.

Bonding for pumper truck was discussed with no action taken.
