**Public Hearing Local Law #1 of 2007
Village Hall**

Village Mayor Toni Campbell called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. Board members present were Trustees Amy Clark, Mark Doeberl and Gerald Hayes. Trustee Kim Boomhower was absent. Also present were Village Clerk Christian Vischi and approximately 13 members of the public.

Opponents of the proposed local law raised concern over the potential devaluing of property with diminished land use rights. Trustee Hayes also suggested the 1963 local law is sufficient for our village. Some residents also suggested that because they have large parcels, the extra acreage should afford them the right to raise non-domestic animals.

Proponents to the local law cited decreased property value for parcels surrounding individuals who house non-domestic animals, along with noise and odor disturbances.

With no further public comment, Trustee Clark made a motion to adjourn at 7:43 p.m., seconded by Trustee Doeberl. The motion carried 3-0.
