ARTICLE 4 Additions to

Section 8 - No person shall carry or have in their possession alcoholic beverages on any of the streets, sidewalks, parks or public places within the Village of Earlville, except in a sealed container and wrapped in paper bags or other suitable material. Any person violating any provision of this Local Law shall forfeit and pay a penalty of not to exceed Twenty - Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offence.

Section 9 - No person shall drink or consume any alcoholic beverage on any streets, sidewalks, parks or public places within the Village of Earlville. Any person violating any provision of this Local Law shall forfeit and pay a penalty of not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each offense.

Section 10 - An open bottle or container in any vehicle shall be presumptive evidence that the same is in possession of all the occupants thereof and in violation of Section 9.
