NOTICE: Pursuant to Article 7 of the Public Officers Law §104-1, notice of this meeting was given to the media on Feb. 11, 2009 and the same posted on the 11th day of February, 2009.

Village Deputy Mayor Mark Doeberl waited to see if additional members of the public would arrive and then called the meeting to order at 7:12 p.m. Board members present were Trustees Mark Doeberl and William Excell. Mayor Toni Campbell and Trustees Gerald Hayes and Henry Moore were excused. Also present were Village Clerk-Treasurer Christian Vischi, Mark Taub of the Partnership for Community Development and three members of the public.

Taub opened the public hearing with discussion and overview of the village's re-application of a "Small Cities Community Development Block Grant" in the amount of \$400,000 with the Office for Community Renewal. The purpose of the hearing was to furnish those in attendance with information concerning amounts available, the range of activities that may be undertaken, the Village's proposed re-application and the views of the citizens of the Village on community development needs. The intended area targeted for the re-application is North Main Street from the center of the Village to the northern limits of the Village, and Preston Street.

A motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Excell and seconded by Trustee Doeberl at 7:58 p.m. The next board meeting will be special board meeting at 6:30 p.m. Monday, March 16.
