Village Deputy Mayor Mark Doeberl called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. Board members present were Trustees Gerald Hayes and Henry Moore. Mayor Toni Campbell and Trustee William Excell were absent. Also present was Village Clerk-Treasurer Christian Vischi.

Village Deputy Mayor Mark Doeberl discussed the total expenditures, the revenues, the tax levy and the tax rates. The general fund budget carries total expenditures of \$378,020.03 and a tax levy of \$187,314.39, decreases of \$12,824.27 and \$4,629.46 respectively from the 2009-2010 budget.

The annual Reorganizational Meeting will be held at 6:30 p.m., followed at 7 p.m. by the regular monthly board meeting on April 13 in the Village Office.

The public hearing was adjourned at 7:08 p.m. on a motion by Trustee Hayes, seconded by Trustee Moore and carried 3-0.
